# AXSWC | JVC & Kenwood Radio Programming Instructions

Follow the steps below to program JVC and Kenwood radios when installing the <u>AXSWC</u>.

1. Locate the main connector on the back of the radio (Figure A).

#### NOTE

If you've exhausted every troubleshooting step offered, contact **Technical Support**.







2. The SWC wire from the radio can be found in the bundle of wires above the main connector, labeled **REMOTE CONT**. (Figure B)



#### **WARNING**

This installation will require a  $\underline{10k}$  ohm  $\underline{14}$  watt resistor (sold separately). (Figure C)

#### **Installation Instructions**

- 1. Connect one end of the resistor to the Blue/Yellow wire from the radio.
- 2. Connect the other end of the resistor to the Brown wire from the **3.5mm adapter** included with the AXSWC (Figure A).

- 3. Proceed with programing the steering wheel controls according to the vehicle specific instructions.
- 4. Once the AXSWC interface indicates the correct radio is programmed (5 LED flashes), remove the resistor.
- 5. Reconnect the **Blue/Yellow** and **Brown** wires without the resistor in place (Figure B).



6. Test the steering wheel controls for proper functionality.

The installation is complete.

## **Manual Programming**

- 1. Program the interface to the vehicle following the vehicle specific instructions.
- 2. Turn the radio off.
- 3. Cycle the key off, then back on. (continued on Page 3)



## **Manual Programming (cont.)**

4. Wait until the interface's light flashes Green once, then goes out.



5. Press and hold the **Volume Down** button on the steering wheel.

### **Hold** Volume Down



6. Hold **Volume Down** until the interface's LED turns solid **Red**, then release.



7. The LED will then go out indicating that the interface is now in **Changing Radio Type** mode. (**continued on Page 4**)

## **Manual Programming (cont.)**

8. Press and hold the **Volume Up** button on the steering wheel until the interface's light turns solid **Red**, then release.

# **Hold** Volume Up



Radio 1 has been programmed.

#### NOTE

Repeat this step four additional times (total of five).

9. Press and hold the **Volume Down** button on the steering wheel until the interface's light turns solid Red. The light will remain solid Red for 3 seconds while it stores the new radio information.



10. After the LED goes out, turn the radio on and test the steering control wheel controls.

The installation is complete.
