


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WIRING & ANTENNA CONNECTIONS (sold separately)

Wiring Harness: 70-7552 Antenna Adapter: 40-NI12

TOOLS REQUIRED

• Panel removal tool • Phillips screwdriver

CAUTION! All accessories, switches, climate controls panels, and especially air bag indicator lights must be connected before cycling the ignition. Also, do not remove the factory radio with the key in the on position, or while the vehicle is running.

DASH DISASSEMBLY

- 1. Unclip and remove the left and right side panels from the factory radio (or pocket in radio delete models).
- 2. Remove (2) Phillips screw securing the climate control trim panel, and then unclip and remove the panel.
- **3.** Remove (4) Phillips screw securing the radio or pocket trim panel, and then unclip and remove the panel.
- **4.** Remove (4) Phillips screws securing the radio or pocket, then unplug and remove the radio or pocket.




KIT ASSEMBLY

ISO DIN radio provisionwith pocket

- Secure the pocket to the radio brackets using the (4) #8 x 3/8" Phillips screws provided. (Figure A)
- **2.** Remove the metal DIN sleeve and trim ring from the aftermarket radio.
- Slide the radio into the bracket/pocket assembly, and then secure it using the screws supplied with the radio. (Figure B)
- 4. Locate the factory wiring harness and antenna connector in the dash and complete all necessary connections to the radio. Metra recommends using the proper mating adapter from Metra and/or Axxess. Test the radio for proper operation.
- **5.** Secure the radio assembly to the dash using the factory screws.
- Attach the (10) panel clips onto the radio trim panel, then snap the panel over the radio assembly to complete the installation.







ISO DDIN radio provision

- Secure the radio brackets to the radio using the screws supplied with the radio. (Figure A)
- Locate the factory wiring harness and antenna connector in the dash and complete all necessary connections to the radio. Metra recommends using the proper mating adapter from Metra and/or Axxess. Test the radio for proper operation.



4. Attach the (10) *panel clips* onto the radio trim panel, then snap the panel over the radio assembly to complete the installation.
