CONNECTIONS TO BE MADE

From the aftermarket radio to the AX-P0904 harness:

- Connect the Black wire to the ground wire.
- Connect the **Yellow** wire to the battery wire.
- Connect the **Red** wire to the accessory wire.
- If the aftermarket radio has an illumination wire, connect the **Orange** wire to it.
- Connect the Blue/White wire to the amp turn-on wire.

The following (3) wires are only for multimedia/navigation radios that require these wires.

- Connect the Blue/Pink wire to the VSS/speed sense wire.
- Connect the Green/Purple wire to the reverse wire.
- Connect the Light Green wire to the parking brake wire.
- Tape off and disregard the following (8) wires, they will not be used in this application: Gray, Gray/Black, Green, Green/Black, Purple, Purple/Black, White, White/Black
- Connect the **Red** and **White** RCA iacks to the front amplifier output iacks of the aftermarket radio.

INSTALLING THE INTERFACE

With the key in the off position:

- Connect the AX-P0904 harness to the AX-P0904 interface.
- Connect the AX-P0904 harness to the AX-P0904 amplifier interface.
- Remove the dust cover from fiber optic port in the AX-P0904 amplifier interface.
- Connect the factory fiber optic cable into the AX-P0904 amplifier interface.
- Connect the AX-P0904 harness to the wiring harness in the vehicle.
